The proposed ordinance amends Appendix D, Article LV of the County Code of Ordinances to update provisions related to the Board of Directors, Terms of Office, Powers, Funding, and Use of Funds. The public purpose is to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Bluewater Bay MSBU Board.
